Please call us or email us to discuss in details your request prior to sending in your handbag.

Instructions:

- Please send the item to be repaired into a box, include the completed form, and send it to your repair
 center. We use either USPS or FedEx when shipping outbound repairs, but you may send your item via the
 carrier of your choice. We suggest that you select a method which provides for package tracking and a
 delivery receipt signature. All items will be returned to the customer with the carrier's minimum
 insurance unless previous arrangements have been made. If you are unable to print a form, you will need
 to contact us to discuss options.
- 2. We will call you to explain your repair/custom request, give you a price quote and turnaround time.
- 3. Upon your approval, we will send you an invoice so you can pay via PayPal or Credit Card and then we will complete your repair and ship the item back to you.
- 4. If you decide not to proceed with the repair after we give you a quote, there will be a \$10 fee to return the item back to you. All of our repairs average \$20-\$75 depending on the condition of the edging/straps and if it's a repair vs. custom coloring.
